TERMS AND DEFINITION

No	Words	Definitions
1	School Type	Refers to a school whether registered under National Education System(NES) or permitted /private
2	School Agency Authority	The authority or body which governs the establishment or operation of a school
3	National Education System (NES)	Schools who are registered under National Education System (NES)
4	Feeder School	A school zoned within the vicinity of a catchment area which children progress to a particular level of education
5	Permitted School	A private school however they get permission to operate using NES curriculum
6	Private School	A schools run by private organization or individual rather than the government
7	Physical Disabilities	Limitation to a student physical functioning, mobility or stamina
8	Intellectual Disabilities	Limitation to a student ability to understand new or complex information and to learn
9	Usable toilet	Usable toilets means main doors are unlock ,toilet not broken, toilet hole not blocked and water is available for flush/pour and closed door locked from inside.
10	Teacher Type	Refers to the person assisting the student in a particular institution
11	Teacher Aide	A person who assist a teacher with instructional responsibilities
12	Highest Academy Qualification	The most advance qualification obtain by a teacher
13	Highest Teaching Qualification	Highest teacher level of education qualification obtain by a teacher
14	Provisional Certificate No.	Certificate number issued to a teacher who is teaching on a transitional period
15	Full Certificate No.	Certificate number issued to a teacher who is teaching on permanent basis
16	Investment Promotion Authority(IPA)	An Organization where private institutions (schools) register their business name, regulations and certification.
